A sector driven by the dynamism of the Norwegian economy

- An increase of road transport, more modern, more economical and more environmental friendly
 - A National Transport Plan (2018-2029) with a budget of over 100 Billions EUR.
 - A budget of 57 Billions EUR in road infrastructures.
 - Proposal to allocate 80,1 Billions NOK allocated to Transport in 2020 (36,3 Billions to roads)
 - Constant increase of new car registrations in Norway. Almost 3 mill. private cars.
 - Almost 100.000 kms of road in Norway
- A boom of electrical cars in Norway
 - More than 260.000 electrical cars in Norway (9% of total cars market in Norway).
 - Goal/Aim to reduce transport time on the highway E39 (1100 km) between Stavanger and Trondheim.

Innovation, profitability, safety and environment

- Rogfast, first floatable tunnel in the world, 26,7 km. Budget 16,7, Billions NOK.
- New road technologies, smart roads.
- Good working conditions, improvement of conditions Health-Security-Environnement.
- Road projects less expensive and more « green ».

MEET THE TWO MAIN NORWEGIAN CONTRACTORS

Statens Vegvesen

The Norwegian Public Roads Administration is an administrative organisation, established in 1864, that works for a safe, environmentally friendly and efficient transport network that meets the society needs in terms of transport and promotes regional development. This administration depends on the Ministry of Transport. Approx. 7000 employees. Budget : 29,8 Mds NOK (2019) Turnover : 60,3 Mds NOK (2019)

Nye Veier

Organisation created by the Norwegian government in 2016 in order to establish a simple and efficient organisation specialised in the construction sector. Their mission is to plan, build, drive and maintain roads' safety. Nye Veier has opened 52 km of 4 secure lanes in 2019. Nye Veier plan to build roads in the next 20 years for a budget of almost 150 Billion NOK (=15 Mds EUR). Nye Veier will build 18 sections of roads in four development zones. Approx. 200 employees.
